St Luke's Church Food Partnership Update 1st May 2020

St Luke's had been looking into partnering with the three Co-op stores locally (South Park, Woodhatch & Trehaven) and when the Coronavirus necessitated isolation and restrictions for many, we thought let's just get on with it and see how God leads blesses this relationship.

On the first collection evening at 7.45pm Anita and Alison literally collected food that would otherwise be wasted from the stores and met at church. They opened the boots of their cars, looked at all the food, look at each other and said, "Now what!?"

Relationships were rapidly developed with Welcare, Sandcross School, Easter Project, Wayside, Loveworks and East Surrey Hospital and we now support them all with food parcels.

St Luke's currently collects from the three Co-op stores four evenings a week (they would love us to collect the remaining evenings) and we then distribute the food in a variety of ways.

Where does the food go?

Two food parcels a week to 10 families linked through Sandcross School & Welcare

Food parcels to families known to us through the church

Bread and pastries to Key Workers at East Surrey Hospital

Food deliveries to Wayside (homeless young women)

Food support to Easter Project

Hoping to link with Loveworks
